Course Description

Essentially, Precalculus is a branch of mathematics in which students extend their learning from Geometry, Trigonometry, and Algebra II to prepare themselves for topics in Calculus.

Materials

Textbook (you may keep this at home *unless* I tell you to bring it to class)

Calculator (TI-83, TI-84, or TI-NSPIRE preferred)

Bathroom Policy
